Tennis Tournament Regulations:

Scoring: Best of three sets, conventional scoring, and a 10-point tiebreaker to break a tie. Alternate scoring may be used due to draw size and/or weather conditions. The match is a default at 15:01 minutes late & considered a 6-0, 6-0 win for the player/team present. If the player arrives before the defaulted time, he/she is to receive a 5 minute injury prevention warm-up.

Awards: Awards will be presented only to Champions. Trophies would be given to first and second place winners in each event.
